

Rick's Ramblers Ramble 2021 Kentish coast-to-coast 24 – 26 September Faversham – Canterbury – Folkestone – Dover



Day 1 – Friday 24 September 2021

Faversham, Whitstable and Canterbury

11am – Ramblers assemble – Faversham Market Place, outside the Bear Inn (nearest long-stay parking – Partridge Lane car park ME13 7JB - £5 per day)

11.10am – Ramble commences – Saxon Shore Way – approx 10 miles to Whitstable.
From Whitstable – Crab and Winkle Way – approx 6 miles inland to Canterbury.
Overnight in Canterbury at Canterbury Chaucer Travelodge.



Day 2 – Sat 25 September 2021

Canterbury, the Elham Valley Way and Folkestone

A ramble through the Kentish countryside along the Elham Valley Way, taking in the countryside of Kent – the garden of England, the North Downs and Kentish villages such as Bridge, Bishopsbourne and Kingston.

Finish options at the Rose & Crown in Elham (13miles) or the Coach & Horses in Lyminge (16 miles) – followed by a short taxi ride to Folkestone.

Overnight in Folkestone at the Grand Burstin Hotel.



Day 3 – Sun 26 September 2021

Folkestone, Kent Coast Path, white cliffs and Dover Castle

A 7.5 mile stretch of the Kent Coast path along the famous white cliffs – keep the sea on your right and see if you can see France.

Ramble to Dover Castle before heading to Dover Priory station for the train ride back to Faversham for a pint of Kent's finest and a spot of food before heading home.
